### Constitution of India.

No. MAT-1097/C.R.94/28:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra, is hereby please to make the following rules, regulating recruitment to the posts of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Registrar, Deputy Registrar, Assistant Registrar/Research Officer and Librarian (Recruitment) Rules, 2001.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise, requires,-

(a) "Act" means the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985;

(b) "Benches" means the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal Benches.

(c) "degree" means a degree of a statutory university;

(d) "diploma" means a diploma of a statutory university;

(e) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

(f) "High Court" means the Bombay High Court of Judicature at Mumbai;

(g) "Judicial officers rules" means the Bombay Judicial Officers (Recruitment) Rules, 1956;

(h) "Tribunal" means the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal;

3. Appointment to the post of Registrar in the Tribunal shall be made either,-

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the

basis of strict selection from amongst the persons holding the post of Deputy Registrar of the Benches having not less than three years regular service in that post; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,-

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than fifty years of age;

(ii) possess a degree in law; and

(iii) (a) is an Advocate, having not less than eight years standing practice in Tribunal or in the High Court and the courts subordinate thereto; or

(b) Judicial Officers of Junior Branch in the State Judiciary as defined in rule 3 of the Judicial Officers rules, with not less than eight years experience; or

(c) Judicial Officers of Senior Branch in the State Judiciary as defined in rule 3 of the Judicial Officers rules, with not less than eight years experience; or

(c) by deputation of a suitable person from the cadre of a District Judge.

4. Appointment to the post Deputy Registrar in the Tribunal shall be made either,-

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of strict selection from amongst the persons holding the posts of Assistant Registrar or Research Officer having not less than three years regular service in that post; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,-

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than fifty years of age;

(ii) possess a degree in a law; and  
(iii) is an Advocate, having not less than six years standing practice in the Tribunal or in the High Court and the courts subordinate thereto; or

(c) by deputation of a suitable person from, -

(i) the Judicial Officers belonging to the Maharashtra Judicial Service (Senior Branch) as defined in the Judicial Officers rules; or

(ii) the Officers holding an equivalent post in the Ministerial Services of the High Court or courts subordinate thereto; or

(iii) any other Government service holding an equivalent post and possess the legal qualification mentioned in clause (b)

(ii) of this rule.

5. Appointment to the post of Assistant Registrar/ Research Officer in the Tribunal shall be made either,-

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority, subject to fitness, from amongst the persons holding the post of Sheristedar/Superintendent having not less than three years regular service in that post:

Provided that if the promotion is for the post as Research Officer, the person holding the post of Sheristedar or Superintendent shall possess three years of Judicial work in a Court of Law or in the Tribunal or any other Judicial or Tribunal; or

(b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,-

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than fifty years of age;

(ii) possess a degree in law; and  
(iii) is an Advocate, having not less than four years standing practice in Tribunal or in the High Court and the courts subordinate thereto; or

(c) by deputation,-

(i) of a suitable person from the Judicial Officers belonging to the Maharashtra Judicial Service (Junior Branch) as defined in the Judicial Officers rules; or  
(ii) from the Officers holding an equivalent post in the Ministerial Services of the High Court or courts subordinate thereto; or

(iii) any other Government Service holding an equivalent post and possess the legal qualification mentioned in clause (b)

(ii) of this rule.

6. Appointment to the post of Librarian in the Tribunal shall be made either,-

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority, subject to fitness, from amongst the persons working as Assistant on the establishment of the Tribunal and who possess a diploma in Library Science with not less than three years working experience in Library Section; or

(b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,-

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than fifty years of age;

(ii) possess a diploma in Library Science; and

(iii) having working experience of two years as Librarian or an Assistant Librarian; or

(c) by deputation of a suitable person holding an equivalent post on the establishment of the Tribunal or the High Court or a courts subordinate thereto or any other Government service possessing qualification and experience mentioned in clause (b) of this rule:


Provided that preference may be given to a candidate holding a degree in Library Science.

7. Appointment by promotion and by nomination to the posts shall be made in the ratio of 50:50

8. The persons appointed to the posts by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

9. The persons appointed to the posts whether by promotion or nomination, shall be required to pass the examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted, from passing those examinations.
